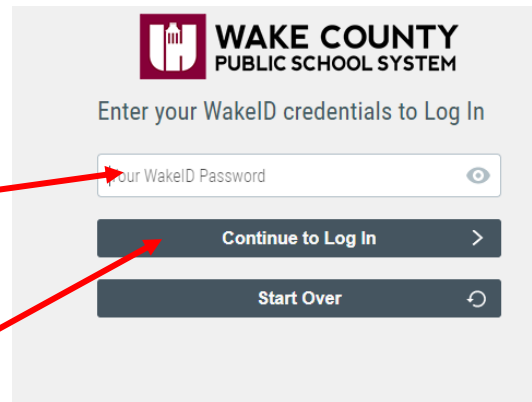

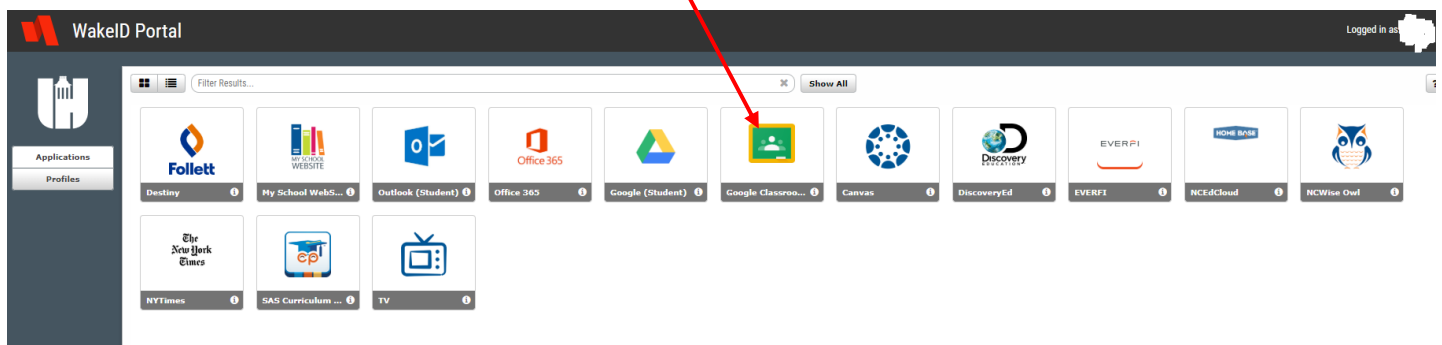

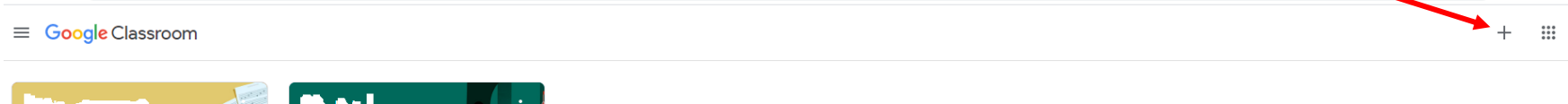

Click on “Google Classroom”

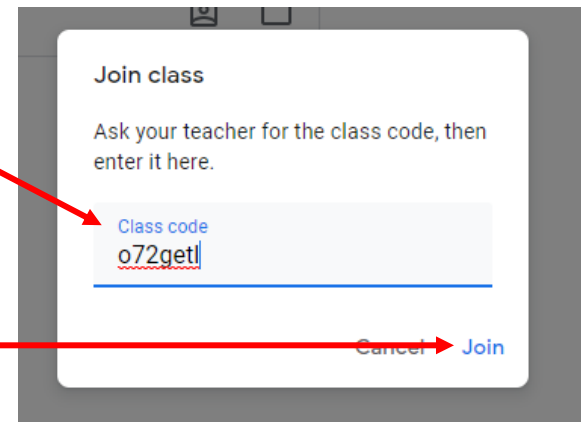


Click on the plus sign in the upper right hand corner. Your child's Google Classroom screen should be blank.




Enter the class code in the box labeled “Join Class” when it prompts you. Then click “Join”
